DESCRIPTION

Seeking to delineate your patient's complaints of dizziness and/or vertigo and the relationship to balance and falls? Looking for a solid treatment and reassessment approach to improve outcomes? This lecture and lab-based class will review the anatomy and physiology of involved structures in addition to the differential diagnosis and treatment for dizziness and vertigo—including an overview of vestibular rehabilitation.
