DESCRIPTION

Sifting through the literature supporting aphasia intervention can be a daunting task. However, this seminar is designed to give you the tools needed to develop treatment plans that are well-established in the research. After reviewing some of the stroke and aphasia recovery basics, you will learn the methodology of 15 treatments shown to improve the various areas of deficit in this population. In addition, the current state of treatment research related to primary progressive aphasia will also be discussed. Her teaching, research, and service interests are in adult neurogenic communication disorders, especially issues of quality of life in the chronic stages of recovery. Dr. Odom is a Certified Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Care Trainer through the National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners (NCCDP).
