**Early registration deadline: October 17, 2018**

The registration fee for dentists is \$125 Day 1, \$125 Day 2, \$215 Both Days; for non-dentists the fee is \$95 Day 1, \$95 Day 2, \$115 Both Days; and for students (proof of enrollment required at check-in) the fee is \$75.00 for One or Both Days. These program fees include administrative costs, educational materials, and lunch. If registration is received after the deadline, the total fee will be the registration fee + \$25.00.

MAHEC has a pay-up-front policy for all CE programs. The only exceptions will be for pre-approved programs where an individual payment plan is appropriate.
