AUDIENCE

This course is primarily directed toward maternity care providers, including physicians, nurses, certified nurse midwives, residents, students, EMS, EMTs, and paramedics.

OBJECTIVES

- Discuss methods of managing pregnancy and birth urgencies/ emergencies, which standardizes the skills of practicing maternity care providers
