DESCRIPTION

The treatment of adolescents with substance use disorders is an increasingly challenging mission, given the evolving complexity and seriousness of the problem and the limited array of treatment options. However, recent advances in our understanding of the problem has led to the development of a range of evidence-based treatment approaches. There is particular efficacy in using treatment models that involve families and communities. This presentation will provide an overview of the issues, current trends and perspectives on adolescent substance use disorders as well as a review of empirically supported family based treatment models. Highly effective strategies for engaging and working with families in adolescent substance use disorder treatment are offered in a perspective that is refreshingly comprehensive and practical.

FACULTY

PAUL D. NAGY, M.S., LPC, LCAS, CCS, is an Assistant Professor in the Duke University School of Medicine where he has worked for the past 28 years in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences in a variety of clinical, research, teaching and administrative positions. He holds degrees from Duke University and Florida State University and is a Licensed Professional Counselor, a Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist and a Certified Clinical Supervisor. Mr. Nagy has more than 30 years of clinical, research, administrative and teaching experience and has conducted seminars and workshops to audiences throughout the United States. Mr. Nagy has also worked as an Expert Content Director overseeing the development of Treatment Improvement Protocols and Technical Assistance Publications for The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). He is the author of several book chapters published by the American Psychiatric Press. Mr. Nagy is a member of the Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers (MINT) and works closely with a number of behavioral treatment and community health organizations to facilitate the adoption of evidence based practices. He was a 2008 recipient of the Triangle Business Journal Health Care Hero Award and the 2016 Advancing Evidence Based Practices Award from the North Carolina Evidence Based Practices Center.
