DESCRIPTION

Roy Kiessling returns to offer an Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) Basic Training & Refresher, "Integrating EMDR into Your Clinical Practice," in two parts at MAHEC in Asheville, NC. This EMDR training includes EMDR International Association (EMDRIA) Approved Part 1 & Part 2 weekends, plus the 10 required hours of basic consultation. The two-part training may also be utilized as an excellent refresher course for previously trained providers.

AUDIENCE

Master's level mental health professionals, including mental health and substance abuse counselors, social workers, psychologists, marriage and family therapists, school counselors and other professionals interested in this subject. Interns and Students must be enrolled in a Master's or Doctoral program. Training eligibility for other healthcare professionals is considered. MDs need a medical specialty in Psychiatry, Nurses need a Master of Science in Nursing with specialty in psychiatric nursing. Participants registering at the nonprofit/student/ peer support rate must show proof at time of registration.

FACULTY

Roy Kiessling, LISW, ACSW, completed his EMDR Basic training in 1995, became a training facilitator for Francine Shapiro's EMDR Institute in 1997, the senior trainer for Shapiro's humanitarian projects in 2001, and a senior trainer for Shapiro's EMDR Institute in 2006. Roy has participated in humanitarian projects in Bangladesh, Poland, the Middle East, and Russia, as well as in domestic disaster areas affected by Hurricane Katrina. In 2006, he received the Liz Sinker Outstanding Volunteer of the Year Award for his numerous volunteer projects in support of the EMDR Community. In June of 2013, Roy founded EMDR Consulting, a consulting and training organization specializing in integrating EMDR into clinician's clinical practice. Since then, EMDR Consulting has grown, offering EMDR Consulting and the EMDRIA approved EMDR Basic course, "Integrating EMDR into your Clinical Practice," throughout the United States.

Getting to the Core of the Problem: Treating the Cause, Not the Symptom

Sunday, July 28, 2019

No prerequisites are required to attend! This workshop is open to all mental health clinicians.

Recently, psychotherapy has placed a greater emphasis on trauma informed approaches to case conceptualization and treatment. Recent advances in neurobiology have supported the hypothesis that past disturbing or traumatic events are stored differently in the brain than normal events. These neural networks carry a higher emotional charge. Because of this emotional encoding, the linkage, binding, and reconsolidation of these neural networks with adaptive neural networks becomes more difficult.

This workshop will discuss the neurobiology of memory, the process of identifying core beliefs, and their use in case conceptualization and treatment.
