

SPECTRUM OF PERSONALITY STYLES:

A 9-V Integrative Approach

DESCRIPTION

Taught by internationally renowned Enneagram Master, Honorary Founder and previous Board Member of the International Enneagram Association, Dr. Jerome Wagner, this course is suitable for novices and Enneagram enthusiasts alike.

You've heard of 3D. Jerry Wagner introduced 9Vs to reflect the multidimensional beauty and complexity of the Enneagram personality styles. Arranged under nine "Vs," Wagner's system creates a 9 x 9 symmetrical matrix that is comprehensive, yet easy to understand. This one-day workshop clearly illustrates the nine Vs of each personality style, providing answers to commonly-asked questions and getting to the core of what makes each one "tick:"

- 1. Values: What motivates, excites, and enthuses each style?
- Visions: Worldviews of each style. What each style envisions as their purpose. Representative adaptive and maladaptive schemas of each style.
- 3. Vulnerabilities: Highly sensitive areas of each style, which may easily result in emotional reactivity
- **4. Virtues:** Love expressed in an undistorted way, emanating from healthy emotional schemas that reflect the "true self"
- **5. Vices:** Addictive reactions originating from the "false self," and love expressed in a distorted manner
- Vectors: Connections and internal flow among the nine styles what each style experiences under relaxed or stressful conditions
- 7. Venues: The enVironmental conditions under which human beings grow up—nurture that grows or slows our nature
- 8. **deVelopment:** Interactions of nature and nurture throughout the life-cycle
- 9. Vicissitudes: Chance encounters, unpredictable vagaries, and variations that keep occurring during our lives, making all personality theories—including the Enneagram—always tentative

Mental health practitioners and spiritual directors, including licensed clinical psychologists, licensed professional counselors, clinical social workers, marriage and family therapists, and clergy members. We also invite others who are interested in personality development, interpersonal dynamics, groups, and personal growth.

FACULTY



Jerome Wagner, PhD, is an internationally recognized Master of the Enneagram; a clinical psychologist, therapist, supervisor, and consultant in private practice; and a faculty member in the Department of Psychology at Loyola University, Chicago. He is the author of Nine Lenses on the World: the Enneagram Perspective; The Enneagram Spectrum of Personality Styles: an Introductory Guide; and the Wagner Enneagram Personality Style Scales, a validated Enneagram inventory,

as well as a 6-section audio publication: Two Windows on the Self: the Enneagram and Myers-Briggs. Jerry has been researching and teaching the Enneagram for more than 40 years and has offered the Enneagram Spectrum Training and Certification Program on a national and international level for the past 20 years. Dr. Wagner's dissertation was one of the first written descriptions of the Enneagram and he pioneered formal research studies on the Enneagram. Inherent in his study was the construction of an Enneagram inventory, which has evolved over the years. The current version and manual of his highly researched and statistically validated Wagner Enneagram Personality Style Scales (WEPPS) may be taken online and is also available in hard copy from Western Psychological Services. An invited speaker at all of the International Enneagram Association (IEA) Conferences, Dr. Wagner has served on the Board of Directors of the IEA, has been the editor of the Association's NinePoints Bulletin, and co-editor of The Enneagram Journal. He has published numerous articles in these journals as well as the Enneagram Monthly. For his early and continuing contributions to the Enneagram community, Dr. Wagner was honored by being named a Founder of the International Enneagram Association. He was the keynote speaker for the 2010 IEA Global Conference, the IEA China 2013 Conference, and the IEA European 2017 Conference. He has presented Enneagram workshops for business consultants and coaches, human resource directors, counselors, therapists, spiritual directors, educators, and personal growth audiences throughout the United States and in Canada, England, Spain, Australia, Hong Kong, and Singapore.

REGISTRATION

Early registration deadline: June 3, 2019

The registration fee is \$169.00, \$149.00 for groups of five or more from the same agency (per person; must register/pay at the same time), \$149.00 for Clergy Members, \$149.00 for Students (must provide student ID at check-in), \$20.00 for MAHEC Employees, and \$399.00 for all 3 days.
