DESCRIPTION

Project ECHO® is a lifelong learning and guided practice model that revolutionizes nursing education to provide best-practice specialty care and reduce health disparities. ECHO is led by an expert team that uses multi-point videoconferencing to conduct virtual learning sessions comprised of a short didactic followed by case presentations provided by participants.

This video teleconferencing series, guided by experts, takes place biweekly over 8 modules (one-hour each) and will cover topics specific to school nurses, including:

- Diabetes Management in Schools
- Pediatric Seizure Disorders
- Hypertension (new pediatric guidelines)
- Asthma
- Mental Health (depression/suicide prevention)
- Dermatology: Safe at School? When to Refer
- Return to Learn: Concussion Management
- Motivational Interviewing (MI)

PLEASE NOTE: School nurse participants will be asked to present a real world case to faculty and peers for direct feedback. Nurses will be awarded CNE credit per session and are encouraged have video turned on for attendance verification.

- Identify interventions for assessing and managing dermatological conditions, hypertension, diabetes, mental health disorders, asthma, seizure disorders, and concussions

He later completed a primary care sports medicine fellowship at UNC-CH, where he was the team physician for the Carolina Hurricanes professional hockey team as well as for UNC-CH. Dr. Vaughan moved to WNC in 2013, where he has been employed at MAHEC as the Sports Medicine Director as well as the Primary Care Sports Medicine Fellowship Director. He is active at the national level with the AMSSM (American Medical Society for Sports Medicine) conducting research on a yearly basis. Locally, he serves as the team physician for UNC-A, Warren Wilson College, Carolina Day School, North Buncombe High School, and Asheville Rugby Football Club. Additionally, he is active in the community with coverage of local events-including Special Olympics, Girls on the Run, and multiple mass participation events. His primary professional interests are in non-surgical orthopaedics, ultrasound medicine, and traumatic brain injury/concussion management.
