DESCRIPTION

The rapidly growing population of older adults in the US requires nurses to develop the clinical skills and knowledge to plan, manage and evaluate the complex healthcare needs of older adults. Nurses care for older adults in a variety of settings ranging from active older adults in the community to frail older adults in the acute and long-term care setting. Nurses must be prepared to incorporate health promotion and chronic disease management principles in practice to maximize older adults' functional status and independence. This course will provide registered nurses with a framework of gerontological expertise to prepare them to improve their clinical practice, and to take the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) Gerontological Nurse Certification exam. LPNs are invited to attend this program for professional development but are not eligible to take the ANCC exam.

AUDIENCE

APRNs, RNs and LPNs. LPNs are welcome to enroll for professional development but are not eligible for the exam.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this activity, participants will be able to:

- Prepare themselves for the ANCC Gerontological Nurse Certification Exam
- Promote positive attitudes in gerontological nursing through person-centered and culturally relevant care
- Translate geriatric knowledge and skills into quality care for older adults in diverse settings including acute, long term, and community-based care
- Discuss the impact of normal age-related changes and chronic disease in the planning & delivery of nursing care
- Examine the implications of regulatory, legal, and health policy issues for nursing practice related to the care of older adults
- State the scope and standards of practice for the gerontological nurse
- Apply palliative care, hospice and pain management principles to care of the older adult

REGISTRATION

Early registration deadline: March 26, 2018

The registration fee is \$199.00 for Both Days, \$99.00 for One Day Only (attend either Monday or Tuesday), \$179.00 for groups of five or more from the same agency (must register and pay at the same time), \$99.00 for Students (must provide valid student ID at check-in), and \$99.00 for MAHEC Employees. These program fees include administrative costs, educational materials, a light breakfast and lunch. If registration is received after the deadline, the total fee will be the registration fee + \$15.00.

MAHEC has a pay-up-front policy for all CE programs. The only exceptions will be for pre-approved programs where an individual payment plan is appropriate. Registrations received without accompanying payment will not be processed and participants who have not paid the course fee will not be admitted into the program.

Cancellations received at least two weeks in advance of the program date will receive a full refund unless otherwise noted. Cancellations received between two weeks and up to 48 hours prior to the program date will receive a 70% refund unless otherwise noted. No refunds will be given for cancellations received less than 48 hours prior to the program date. All cancellations must be made in writing (fax, mail, or email). From 19-23 (I-26):

Take 240 East to Exit 5B (Charlotte Street). Exit right onto Charlotte Street. At the 4th light, make a left onto Biltmore Avenue. Proceed through 8 traffic lights. At the 9th light, turn right into the DoubleTree Hotel complex.
