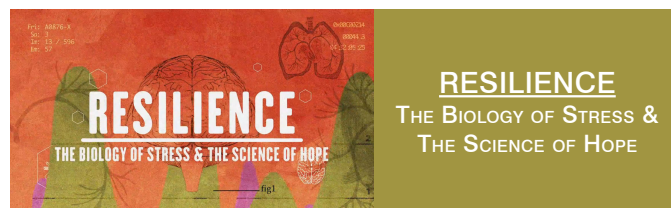
PEDIATRICKS!
