The skill stations are based on an interactive "handson: scenario-based approach" to adult education. The practical testing stations allow the ATCN® students to demonstrate the application of ATCN® information on a moulaged patient.

There are no prerequisites for the full certification course. Your certification must be current for the renewal course.

#### Early registration deadline: February 23, 2023
