and educational research with MAHEC  
for UNCA pre-health students



MAHEC's Center for Health Professions Education in collaboration with UNC Asheville's Pre-Health Professions Program is offering an undergraduate internship for UNC Asheville students interested in health science professions.

- Work with MAHEC Family Medicine, Ob/Gyn, Dental, and Pharmacy faculty and residents and MAHEC administration
- Participate in outpatient clinical experiences and a healthcare-focused research or learning project

This internship provides a working knowledge of and experience in a clinical practice. Students will spend approximately half of their time in clinical shadowing. Educational opportunities include enrichment activities and interaction with residents and medical students.

The other half of the intern's time will involve working with faculty and administration on research and organizational outreach projects. Projects will vary, depending on student, faculty, and organizational needs.

## Requirements

Applicants must be junior or senior pre-baccalaureate pre-health or science majors. Applications should include:

- Personal statement describing the student's interest in and qualifications for the internship (not to exceed one typed page)
- Official transcript
- One faculty recommendation
- Student's phone number and email address

## Application submission is open and ongoing through February 16, 2015.

The UNC Asheville Pre-Health Professions Advisory Committee and the Dean of Natural Sciences will pre-screen applications and recommend highly qualified applicants to MAHEC's Undergraduate Internship Committee for further consideration. Interviews will be conducted at MAHEC and final selection/award notification will be sent by mid-March.
