MAHEC's Center for Health Professions Education in collaboration with UNC Asheville's Pre-Health Professions Program is offering an undergradute internship for UNC Asheville students interested in health science professions.

- Work with MAHEC Family Medicine, Ob/Gyn, Dental, and Pharmacy faculty and residents and MAHEC administration
