Be aware of transcripts and
transfer credit such as: Early

Transfer Credit.

in extracurricular activities:
Sports, jobs, clubs,
organizations, volunteering.

What Can I do in College?

In North Carolina, to become a Registered
Dietitian, you must...

Complete an educational program certified by
ACEND. This can be a Bachelor's or Master's
Degree. [Western Carolina University](#) has a
Bachelor's of Science program in this field.

Partake in a Dietetic Internship (DI) in North
Carolina (unless you completed a Coordinated
Program that includes internship hours. [UNC](#)
has a CP program). This qualifies you to sit for
the exam to become a registered dietitian.

Apply for state license in North Carolina.

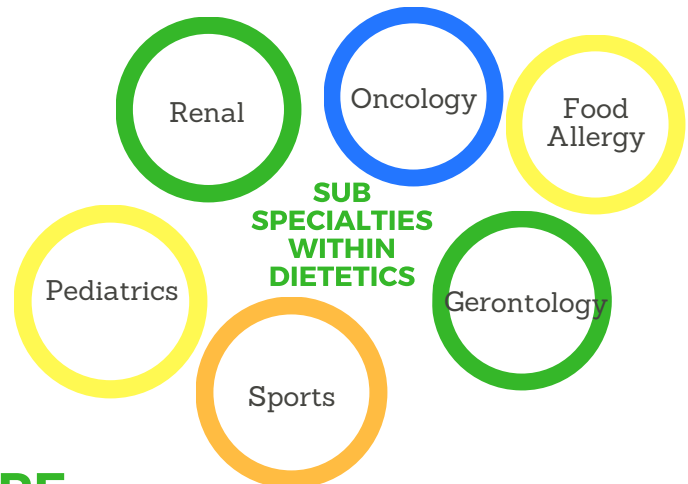
