



## REGEN-COV (CASIRIVIMAB AND IMDEVIMAB) Infusion Treatment

### What to Expect

#### Before Your Visit

- MAHEC will call you for a pre-visit screening. You will be asked about your symptoms and medical history. We will schedule your appointment if an infusion is right for you.

#### The Day of Your Visit

- The tent is temperature-controlled with both heating and air conditioning. Please dress in layers and bring a jacket or other clothing to help keep you comfortable.
- **Please use the bathroom before your appointment. There is no restroom in the treatment tent.**

#### Arriving for Your Appointment

- When you arrive at the MAHEC campus, follow the green signs to the Acute Care Clinic. The big white and blue tent in the parking lot is the infusion tent.
- Park in space 120, 121, or 122. These spaces are located next to, and to the right of, the door of the tent. Please remain in your car.
- A nurse will meet you and escort you into the tent. There you will meet with the provider to go over the consent process and any questions you may have.



#### Receiving Your Treatment

- You will be seated in a chair for your infusion.
- Your nurse will place an IV and start to monitor your vital signs.
- During your infusion you will have your vital signs taken every 15 minutes. The infusion will last one hour,



#### After Your Treatment

- For one additional hour, the nurse will take your vital signs every 15 minutes to monitor you for any side effects.
- After this monitoring period, your nurse will take out the IV.
- The nurse will go over your discharge paperwork with you.
- We will make sure you have a telehealth appointment with your primary care provider within one week after your infusion.
- If you do not have a primary care provider, the nurse will schedule a follow-up telehealth appointment with Dr. Stephanie Call at MAHEC Internal Medicine.
- A nurse will accompany you as you exit the tent and return to your car.
