If repeat test is negative, patient should continue to quarantine for a total of 14 days after last contact to person with COVID-19*. Repeat test immediately if develop COVID-19 symptoms.
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ASYMPTOMATIC, not a close contact No need to isolate or quarantine while awaiting COVID-19 test results. If COVID-19 test results return positive, patient should isolate themselves until meet criteria for release from isolation. If COVID-19 test results return negative, patient can continue with their regular activities. Repeat test immediately if COVID-19 symptoms develop.
