




### Food Insecurity Exists in Every Community

### **Food Insecurity by Household Characteristics**



#### **Different from Poverty**


**58%** of people struggling with hunger have incomes above the federal poverty level and 61% of people living in poverty are foodsecure


# Making Tough Choices

Feeding America's clients report that their household income is inadequate to cover their basic household expenses.





**Figure 1.** Cheng, PCD, 2012. Median annual household income and age-adjusted mortality per 100,000 population aged birth to 75 years, 2002-2006. Bars represent 25th (\$29,631) and 75th (\$39,401) percentile delineations of median household income for 3,139 US counties. Counties are grouped by median household income levels into low-income (n = 785); mid-income (n = 1,570), and high-income (n = 785) counties.

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### **Food Insecurity = Higher Healthcare Costs**

- More chronic disease treatment
- More diabetes hospitalizations
- More hospital readmissions
- High-Cost User status associated with food insecurity
- Food insecure patients cost health care system \$1,863 more per year, or ~ \$155 more per person per month

Food Insecurity \$77.5 billion in additional health care costs per year
