MAHEC's Department of Health Careers and Diversity Education, the WNC Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) and Southwestern Community College, invite you to participate in the 1st Annual Health Careers Education Awareness Conference. The conference will take place on **Tuesday, September 23, 2025 at Isothermal Community College. The Expo is scheduled from 8:30a.m. to 10:30 a.m.**

What is the Health Careers Education Awareness Conference? The conference was created to provide information, resources and education to high school students interested in pursuing a career in healthcare. At least 200 students are expected to attend from the southeasternmost counties of North Carolina plus over 50 healthcare professionals, educators, community leaders and health science students. This conference is also designed to build linkages and partnerships with and between the education and healthcare communities.

What is the Health Career Expo?

The Expo provides a one-on-one forum for students to interact directly with health care professionals and health science students. Over 20 healthcare professions are represented with display booths, information, tools of the trade and representatives present to educate and inform students about what it is like to work in a particular career, what is required academically and the real life realities of work. Students visit career booths they are interested in pursuing as well as being exposed to careers they may have little knowledge of.

There is no cost for exhibitors to participate in the HCE.

PREPARATION AND TIPS

Before the Conference:

- **Know your audience** – 9th through 12th graders from western NC counties. Remember what it was like to be a student!
- **Create a display** about your health care occupation
- **Educate your booth representative(s)** - be ready to answer questions about the occupation's work environment, educational and experience requirements, your personal experiences and community involvement.

At the Conference:

- **Provide handouts** about the occupation and your organization (business cards, brochures, etc.).
- **Make it interesting!** Have physical objects that students can touch, feel or observe related to your occupation.
- Be proactive and **interact with students.**
