2179 behavioral health patients\* seen at MAHEC in six months = 145% of goal for the year

#### **School-Based Therapy Program**

serves disadvantaged children in county schools

XX school-based therapists hired and embedded in the Buncombe County School System

#### 182 school-based therapy referrals

106 Medicaid 59 un- or underinsured 16 private or commercial insurance

for MH and SU services

#### 5 certified peer support specialists hired; they have served >50 individuals

Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT) services developed

# Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD)

Progress toward goal

#### 520 individuals received MOUD at MAHEC

 $375\ \text{individuals}$  received MOUD in the same period last year

We achieved a 38% increase in people able to receive MOUD = 190% of goal

MAHEC has provided MAT waiver training to 400 providers in this six-month period
