
Coronal Polishing for the DA II

DESCRIPTION

This lecture and lab-based course includes a comprehensive 3-hour lecture, followed by a 4-hour clinical lab session to provide the basic concepts and techniques in polishing all exposed tooth surfaces with a rubber cup or brush driven by a slow speed hand piece. This course meets the education requirements to prepare the DA II for core competence in coronal polishing as mandated by the North Carolina Board of Dental Examiners.

Participants must bring a slow speed hand piece or hygiene hand piece capable of accepting disposable prophy angles. If a hand piece is brought that only accepts individual prophy cups (screw-type or latch type), please bring 6-8 prophy cups along with the hand piece.
