### **DESCRIPTION**

This program will explore ways that individuals, family members, and professionals can prepare older adults to live safely, independently, and comfortably at home and in community as they age. The program expands the concept of aging in place to encompass aging in community.

Preparing to maximize wellbeing while aging requires much more than installing ramps and handrails. This program is intended to help learners consider how to plan for aging in place, regardless of financial circumstances. To live safely, independently, and comfortably requires not only quality housing, but also access to health and community services, social connections, and other resources. The speaker will provide information about several aspects of aging in place, such as living arrangements, safety, home modifications, technology, and affordability.

**MAHEC Mary C. Nesbitt Biltmore Campus** 121 Hendersonville Road, Asheville, NC 28803

From I-40 E: Take Exit 50 and turn left onto Hendersonville Road.

From I-40 W: Take Exit 50B and merge onto Hendersonville Road.

At the first light, turn left into the DoubleTree Hotel complex. Turn left (away from the hotel). You will see a steep driveway on your right. Turn right and go up that driveway to the MAHEC Biltmore Campus.

### From 19-23 (I-26):

Take 240 East to Exit 5B (Charlotte Street). Exit right onto Charlotte Street. At the 4th light, make a left onto Biltmore Avenue. Proceed through 8 traffic lights. At the 9th light, turn right into the DoubleTree Hotel complex. Turn left (away from the hotel). You will see a steep driveway on your right. Turn right and go up that driveway to the MAHEC Biltmore Campus.

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### REGISTRATION
